
Disinfect pruning tools using alcohol or bleach before you start to avoid disease spread.

STEP 2: REMOVE DEAD OR DISEASED WOOD




Cut away any branches that are dead, damaged, or showing signs of disease to protect the rest of the tree.

STEP 3: REMOVE SUCKERS AND WATER SPROUTS




Eliminate shoots growing from the base or straight up from branches.

STEP 4: THIN THE CANOPY



Remove crowded or crossing branches to open up the tree's center.

STEP 5: MAKE CLEAN, CORRECT CUTS



Make angled cuts just above healthy buds or laterals to guide growth.
